Do I have to be going to a four-year college to apply?

No! You can be enrolled in a university, community college, technical school, or even a short certification program! We want to support you no matter the stage of education!

I'm taking CMA courses, does that count? Yes! Our scholarship is open to individuals in programs to grow in their skills as a CMA, CDM, Social Work, AIT, Adult Care Home Operator, and more!

Do I have to work at a LeadingAge Kansas member? At this time, our scholarship is only available to employees of LeadingAge Kansas member buildings. If you are unsure if you are a member, reach out to your administrator.

If I've received a scholarship in the past, can I apply again?

Absolutely! Several previous recipients have been awarded the scholarship multiple times. Let us help you throughout your whole journey!

What should I prepare for my application?

Good question! When applying, you will be asked to attach documentation about your program (such as course enrollment paperwork), as well as two letters of recommendation (one must be from your administrator). We also ask that you provide a professional photo of yourself to be shared if you are selected as a scholarship recipient.
