State Update

KDHE Vaccination Phases announced Jan. 7th

- Phase 1: Healthcare workers, Residents of patients in long term care, senior housing or LTC-supported independent living, workers critical to pandemic response continuity
- Phase 2: Persons aged 65+, congregate settings, high-contact critical workers
- New Kansas vaccine website
- If you operate a Homes Plus, Board and Care Home, adult day care, PACE or other state-licensed only adult care home for which you have not been able to make vaccination arrangements, <u>please take this KDADS</u> survey.
- KDHE webinar recording for Jan. 5 <u>now available</u>
- New Rosie Vaccine poster to post prominently, as you deem appropriate, throughout your campus and in the broader community.





State Update (continued)

- The CDC updated <u>Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of mRNA COVID-19 Vaccines Currently Authorized in the United States</u>. It recommends that individuals who have received a COVID-19 vaccine delay TB testing (tuberculin skin test or interferon gamma release assay) until 4 weeks after the completion of dose 2 of COVID-19 vaccination
- KDADS will be issuing a memo waiving TB testing requirements until after COVID vaccination
- PROVIDER RELIEF FUNDS deadline extended by feds. Deadline for use of state Provider Relief Funds extended to March 1. KDADS wants you to use as much of your funds as possible (for authorized uses.) If you can't, email janis.deboer@ks.gov. No forms for reporting SPARK use available, yet.
