More Federal News

Screening Process for Nursing Home Visitation

CMS confirmed today that they are accepting CDC's updated recommendations for screening individuals prior to entering a healthcare facility (read CDC guidance here). "Active screening" requiring the presence of a live person is no longer required for entry into nursing homes or other healthcare settings. These settings now have the option to implement screening through electronic monitoring or other systems in which individuals self-report before entering the setting.





State Update

- KDADS held a "virtual roundtable" this week to discuss survey and certification issues and Medicaid reimbursement issues with adult care home stakeholders. Thank you to Bill Taylor, Treva Greaser, Aimee Middleton and Doug Yoder for attending the meeting on behalf of nonprofit senior care
- Kansas Senior Care Taskforce discussed their first set of legislative recommendations. The Taskforce will encourage the 2022 Kansas Legislature to explore options for restoring the use of temporary nurse aides.
- Thank you to Charlotte Rathke of Locust Grove Village who did a fantastic presentation to the Senior Care Taskforce on the many challenges and needed fixes for the nursing home survey process.





LeadingAge Kansas Update

The LeadingAge Kansas Board met yesterday to decide our legislative priorities for the 2022 legislative session. A finalized version of the priorities will be available after the Christmas holiday.

Sneak preview: Two of the top legislative priorities are fully-funded Medicaid rates and staffing agency reforms

Next week: The Bob Bethell KanCare Oversight Committee is meeting for two days next week. A special thank you to Dawn Veh who is providing testimony for LeadingAge Kansas on staffing agency challenges and abuses. This is the first time the committee has set aside time to specifically hear about staffing agency issues.

- The Abbott BinaxNow continues be under allocation however the Quidel Quickvue antigen tests are now available.
- McKesson also does still have availability on the CareStart rapid antigen test.

- Due to high demand, they are requesting limiting orders to 30 day supply.
