Federal Update – Vaccine Mandate

- Eastern District of Missouri issued <u>preliminary injunction</u> against CMS mandate for 10 states (including Kansas) pending outcome of lawsuit
- Western District Court in Louisiana issued <u>preliminary injunction</u> against CMS mandate for the remaining 40 states pending outcome of lawsuit
- <u>Memo</u> from CMS stating that they will not enforce mandate rule while it is under court injunction.

Now What?

- Federal government is appealing to US Court of Appeals
- National associations say to be cautious and keep preparing as if the mandate will still go into effect at some point
- Can still go forward (or continue) with your own vaccine requirements

National Says Nursing Home Staffing Provisions in Build Back Better Bill (BBB) are Unworkable

Thanks to many of you who shared your thoughts on the nursing home staffing provisions in Build Back Better. <u>Here's a short</u> <u>paper</u> explaining the LeadingAge national position.

LeadingAge is calling for:

- Amending the two nursing home staffing provisions by adding full funding and hold harmless waivers/exemptions that are workable;
- Eliminate the two provisions and undertake a thoughtful nursing home bill, based on the Care for Our Seniors provisions we and AHCA have already put forward; or
- Instead of these staffing provisions add a new center on nursing home staffing to conduct the staffing ratio study and develop a strategy to address staffing challenges in nursing homes

Ongoing workforce advocacy:

- Adult care home/PACE employee retention program
- "Strike teams" with CDC/KDHE grant
- Temporary aide reauthorization
- RN waiver
- National guard
- Regulatory pathway to temporary shut down while maintaining licensure



- McKesson, Value First's preferred distribution partner, supply chain update:
- The Abbott BinaxNow continues be under allocation however the Quidel Quickvue antigen tests are now available.
- McKesson also does still have availability on the CareStart rapid antigen test.
- Continue to anticipate a two week delay with either antigen option.
- Due to high demand, they are requesting limiting orders to 30 day supply.




Mindfulness Minute

5 Conscious Breaths


