LeadingAge National Update

- Action Alert on the COVID relief we need in the new COVID-19 relief bill
- <u>Letter to Biden Administration's Domestic Policy Council</u> to discuss the hard-learned lessons from the past year, including one very important lesson: <u>we can and must do survey and enforcement differently</u>.

Points LeadingAge plans to advocate for:
