Federal Update

Revised <u>CDC Guidance on infection control in health care settings</u>

- Fully vaccinated health care personnel in long term care no longer have work restriction after COVID exposure
- New admits who are fully vaccinated not required to quarantine if no COVID exposure in the previous 14 days
- CMS encourages homes to report vaccinations on NHSN vaccine module
- OSHA <u>National Emphasis Program Coronavirus Disease 2019</u> (COVID-19) and <u>Updated Interim Enforcement Response Plan for</u> Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) effective March 26th.
