State Update

- Big Question Today: Will the state emergency declaration be renewed?
 - If the emergency declaration is renewed, what Executive Orders will be reissued?
- Today is the last day for TA's to work without being certified
- KS Legislature passed a resolution encouraging Governor to reject federal unemployment bonuses
- KDADS still in process for budget increases and revised testing guidance. More updates in early June. SPA has been submitted for CMS approval on \$15/day increase

Federal Update

- New NHSN training module for vaccination reporting. Slides available here and data collection tools available here
- GAO released a <u>report</u> this month on COVID-19 in nursing homes. This
 report found that during the months of May 2020 through January 2021,
 94% of nursing homes experienced more than one outbreak and on
 average, nursing homes experienced 3 COVID-19 outbreaks.
- Emergency Broadband Benefit monthly discount on internet services to assist households with low incomes. 900+ broadband providers have agreed to participate. Open to eligible new, prior, and existing customers of the internet service provider. Eligibility criteria and outreach information is available here.
- HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra formally <u>swore in Chiquita Brooks-LaSure as Administrator of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)</u>
