Position Against Federal Vaccination Mandate

LeadingAge Kansas opposes any federal edict requiring ANY type of health care provider to mandate staff COVID-19 vaccination as a Condition of Participation in Medicaid or Medicare. This constitutes an ill-conceived government action, fraught with potential for serious negative consequences to the entire healthcare system and the people it serves.

However, if the federal government does, indeed, impose this requirement on nursing homes, it should be applied to all healthcare settings, to avoid the disproportionate and inevitable blow to availability of nursing home care for older Kansans.
