

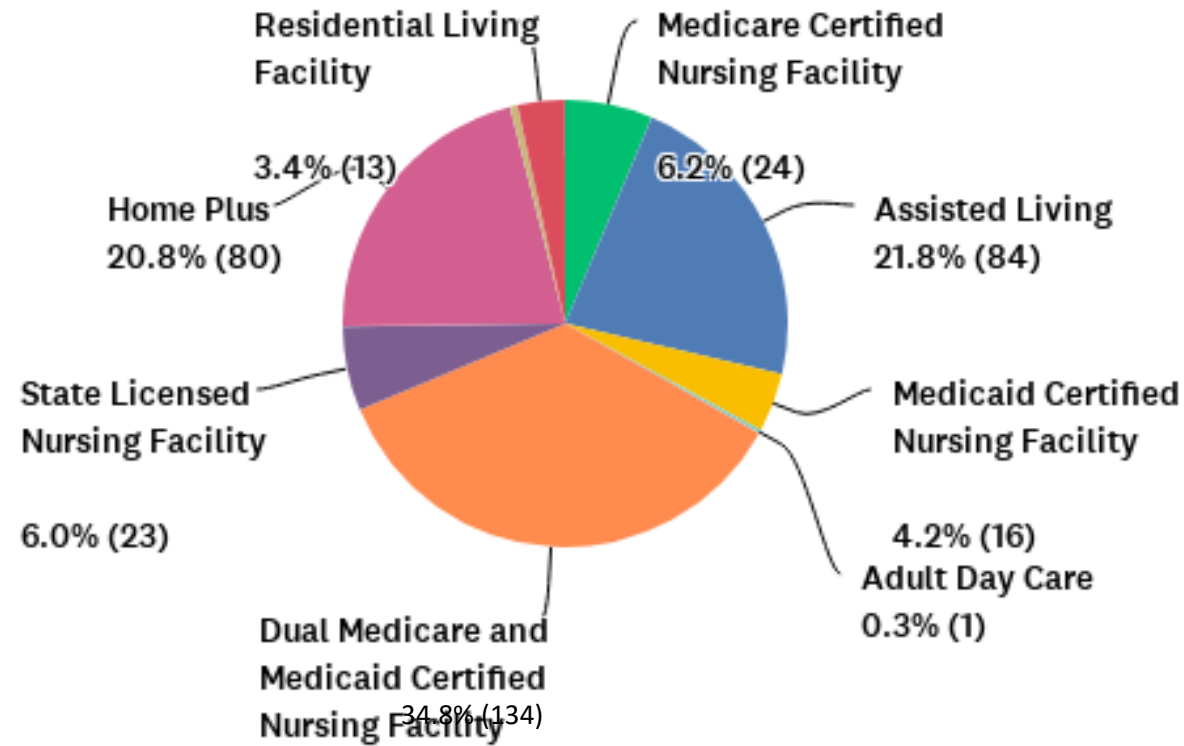
# Adult Care Home and Nursing Facility HB 2016 Survey

# Survey of Adult Care Homes for HB 2016

- KDADS sent SurveyMonkey generated survey link to all licensed adult care homes in the KOTA database.
- Survey sent on July 10<sup>th</sup>
- Responses were closed on July 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 385 responses of *800 facilities licensed (receiving the survey link)*
- Each facility was asked to respond based on the conditions in their building as of July 10<sup>th</sup>
- Facilities part of a chain or ownership group were asked to respond separately for each licensed building.

## Q2 Type of facility responding

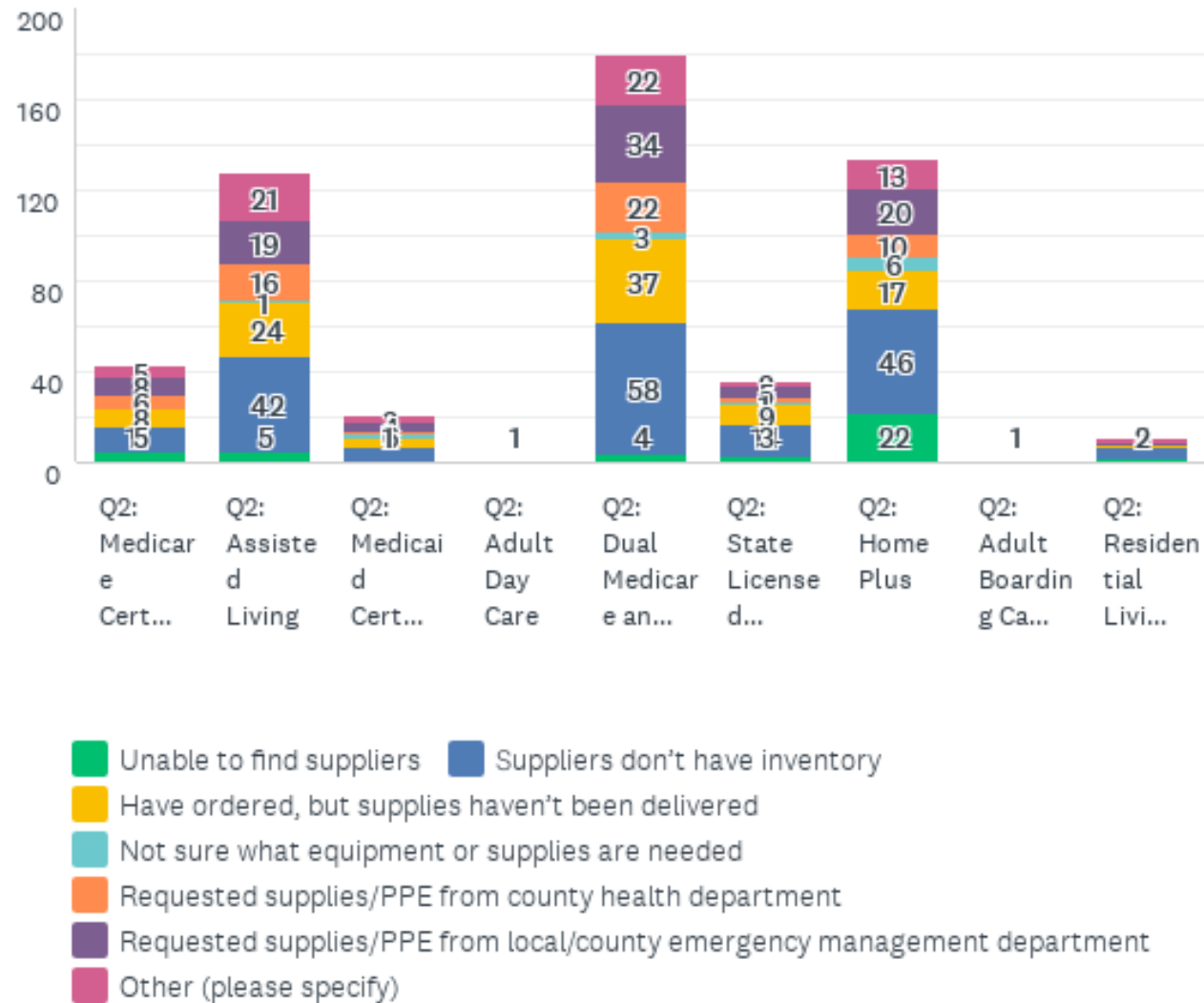

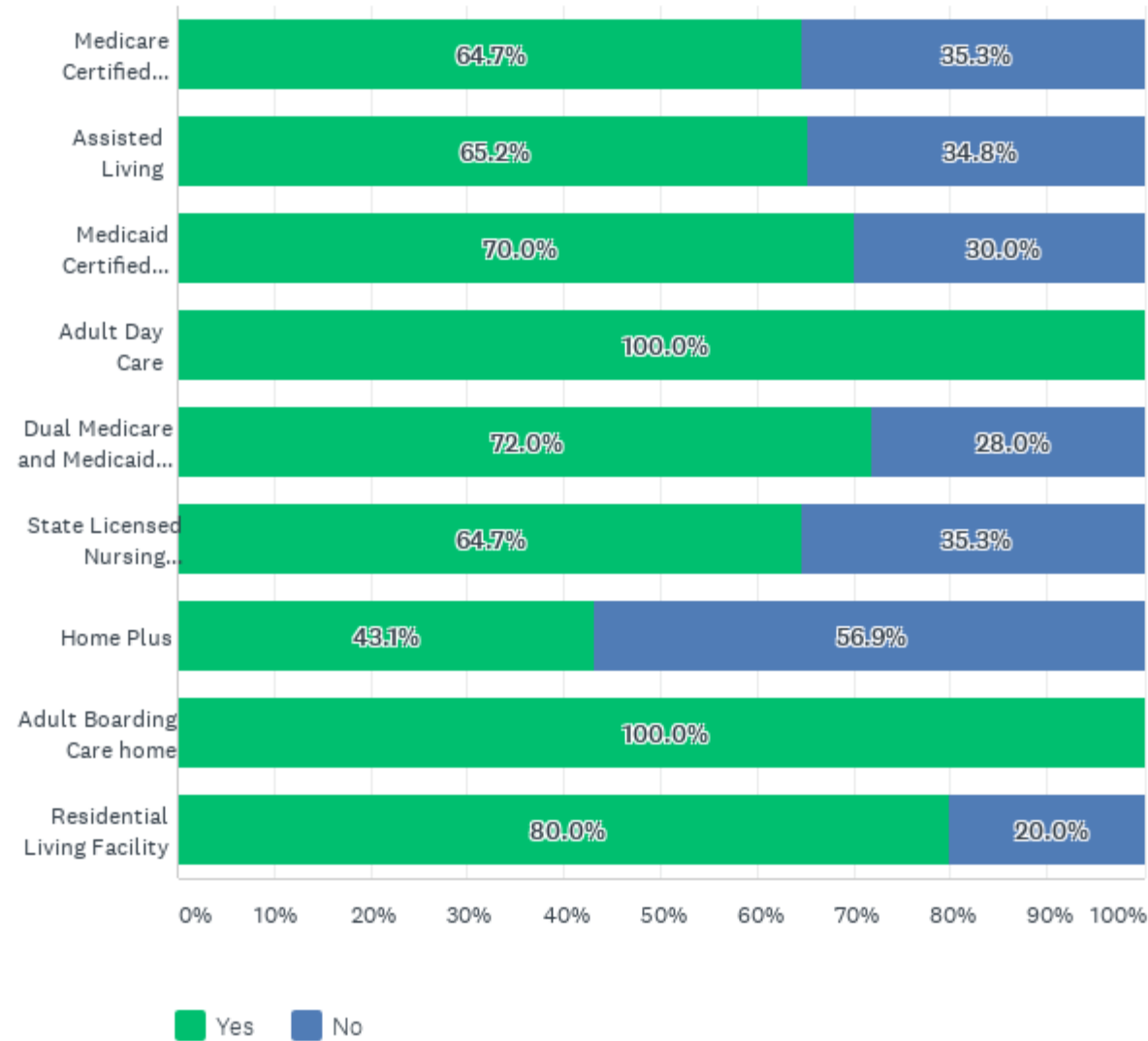

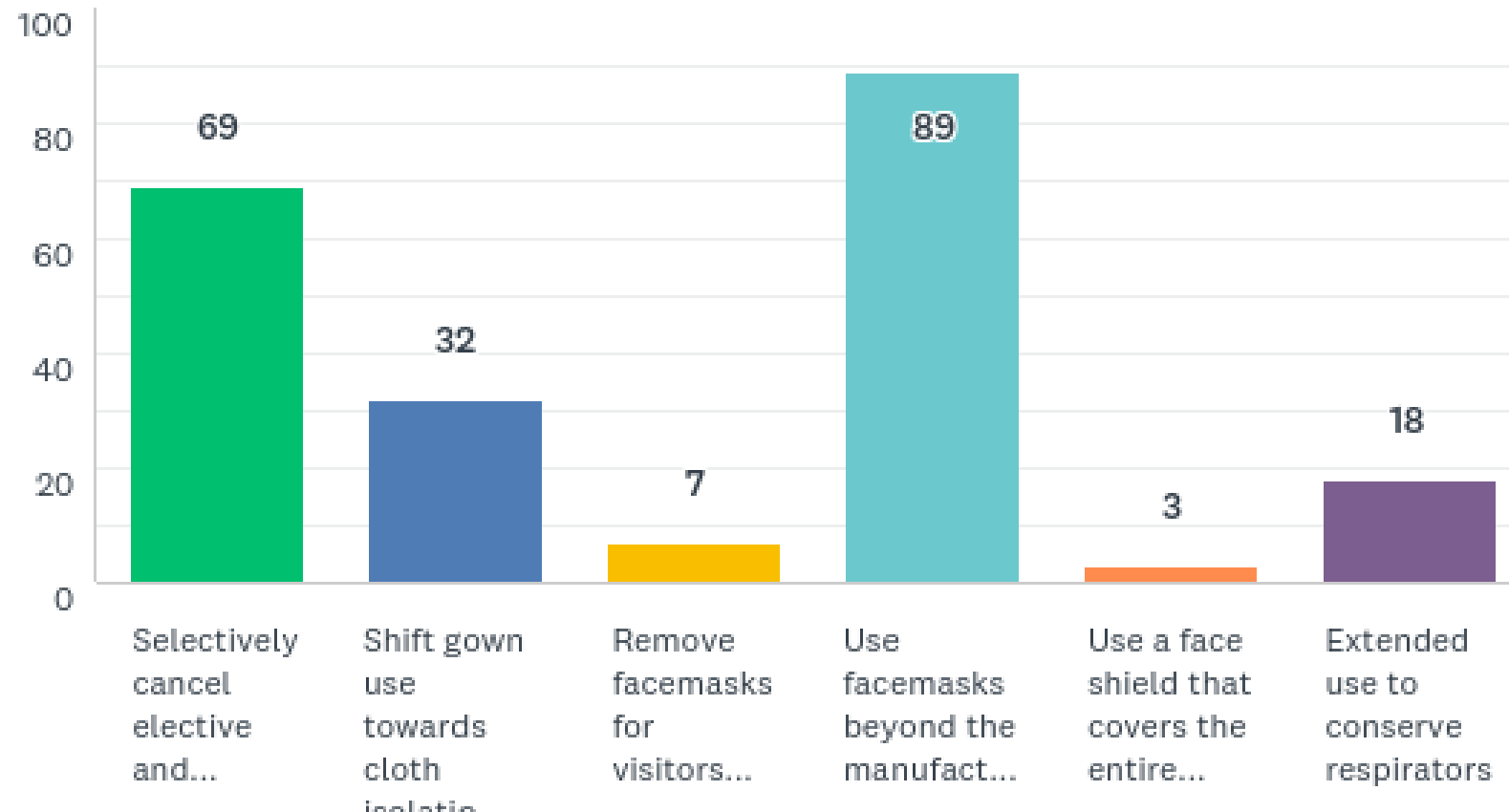
## Q5 Do you have an adequate supply of personal protective equipment?

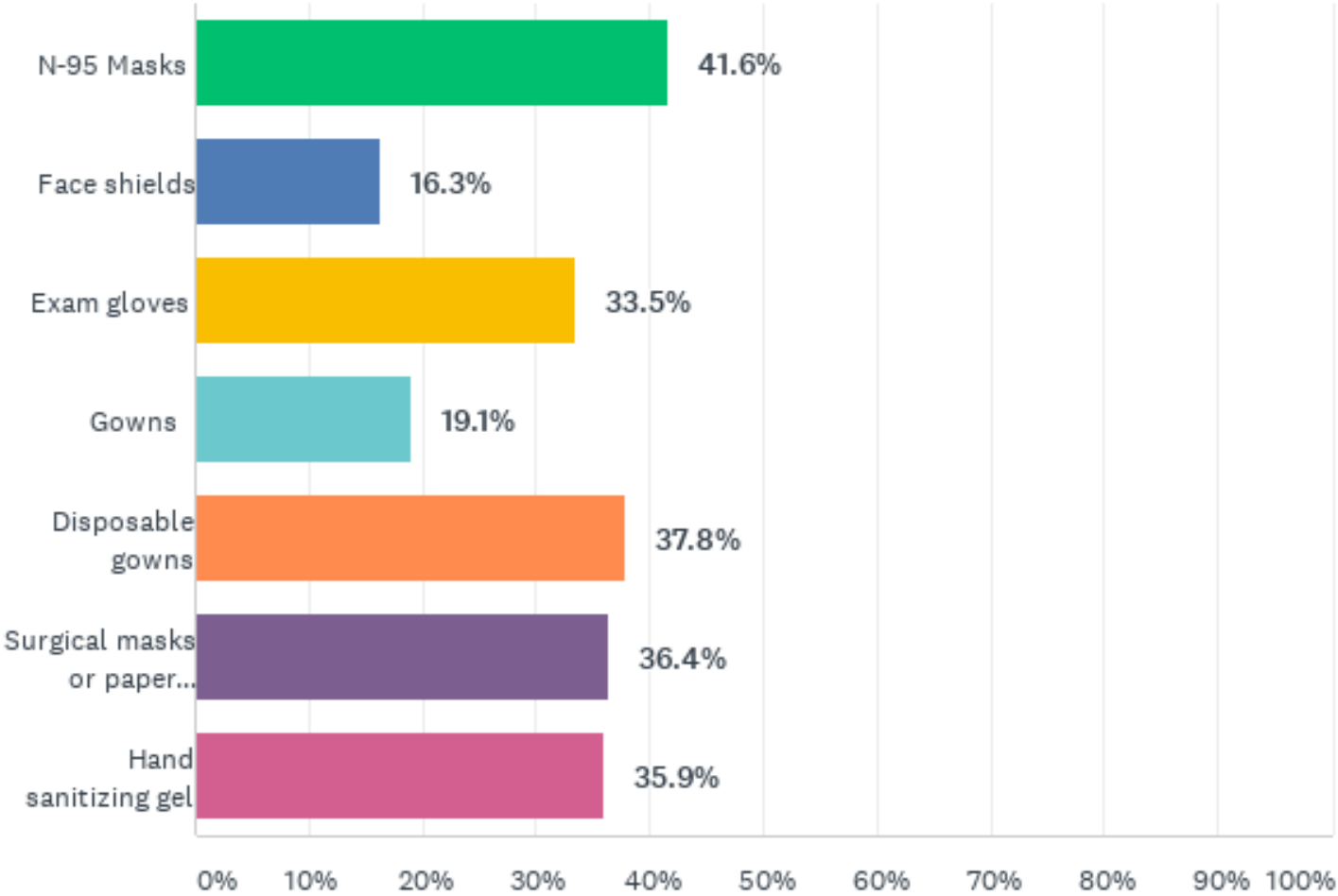

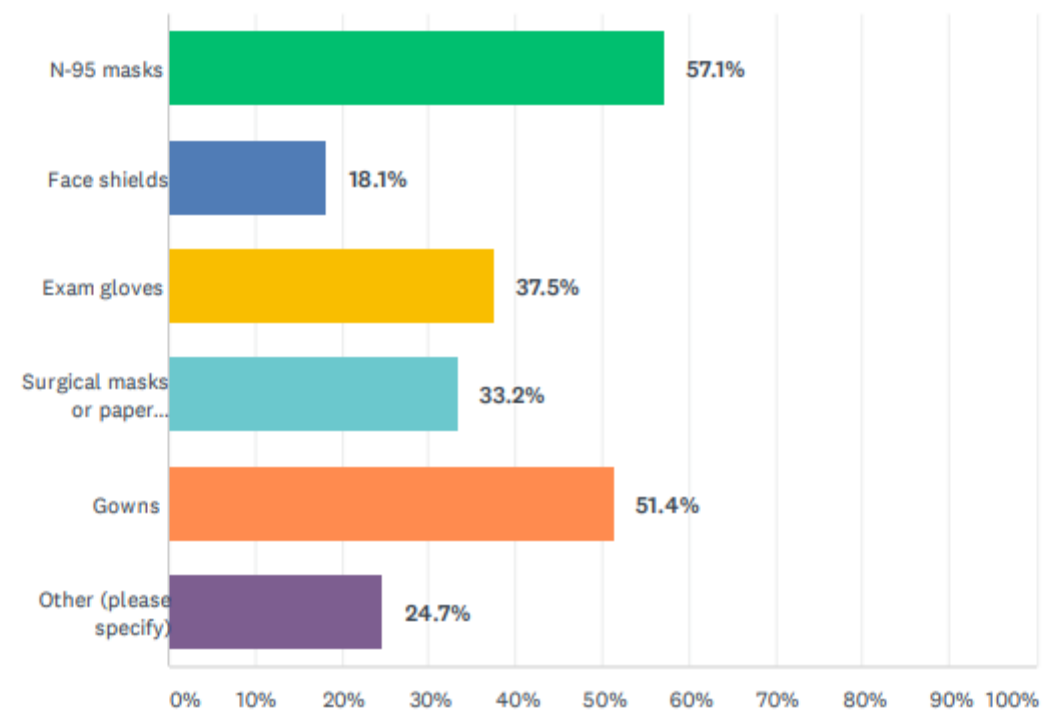


Q10 Check the following items you have an immediate need for? Immediate means that you will run out of these PPE items within the next two weeks.



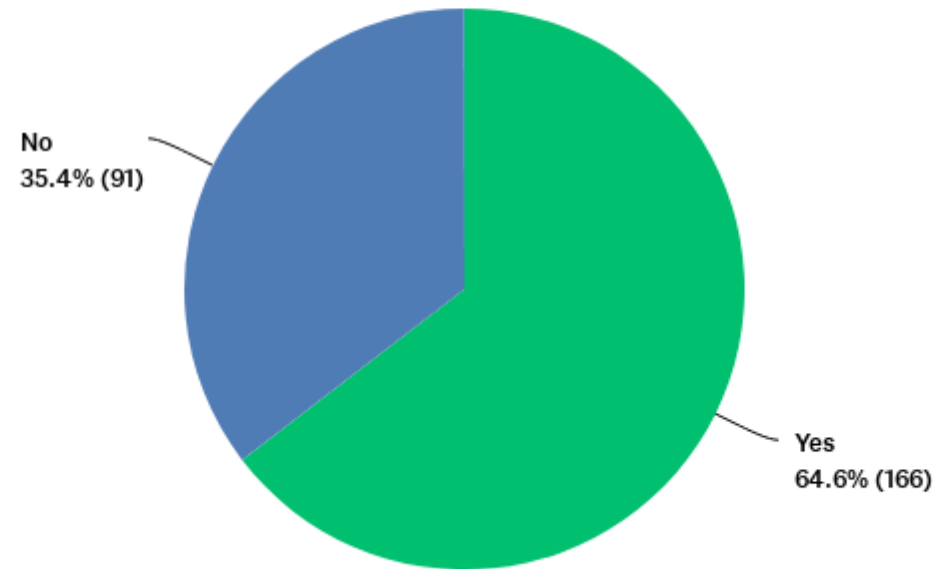
Q14 Which of the following items are difficult for your facility to acquire?

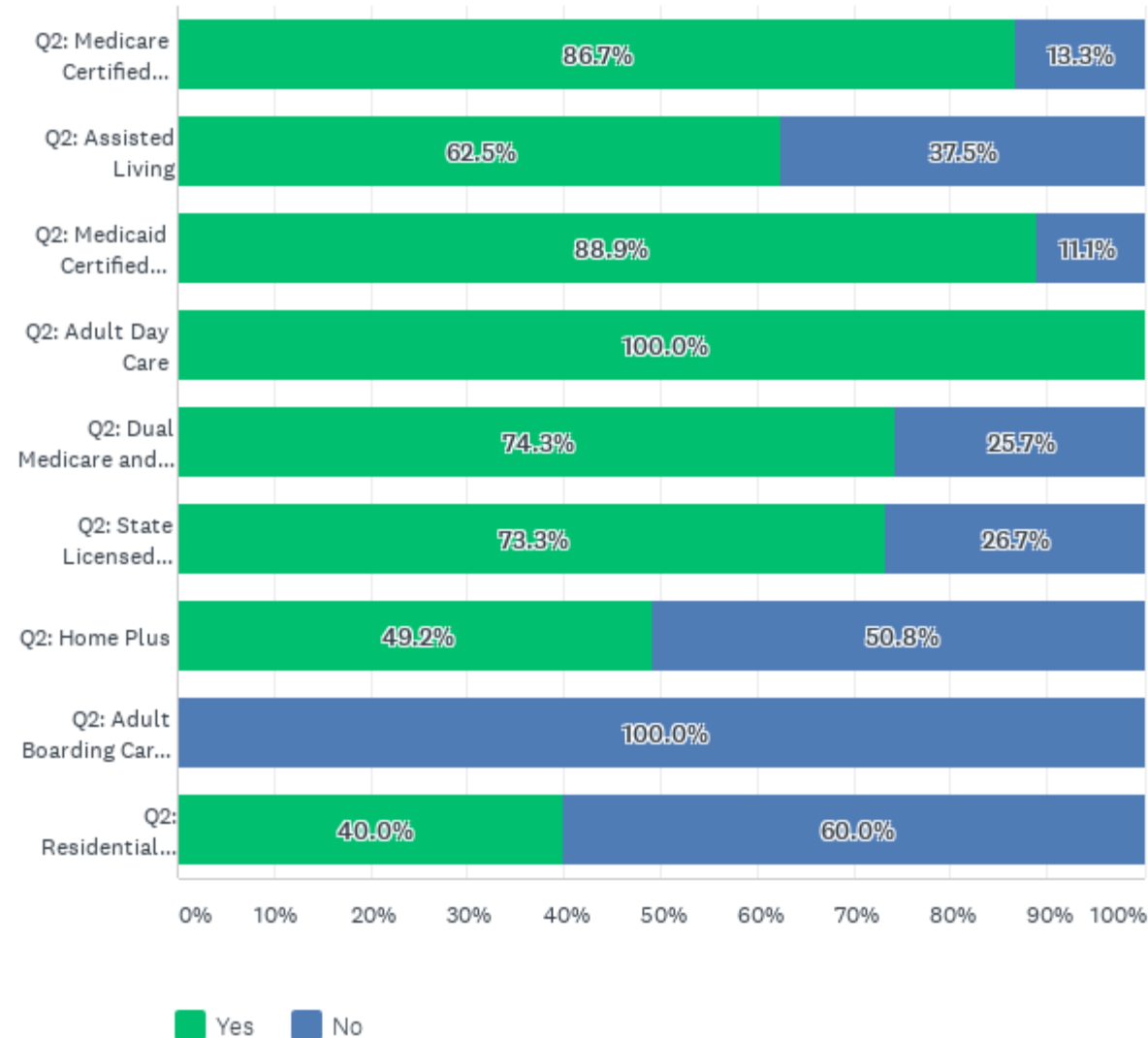

Q8 If you have you contacted your local emergency management officials to obtain personal protective equipment, did you secure PPE through that process?

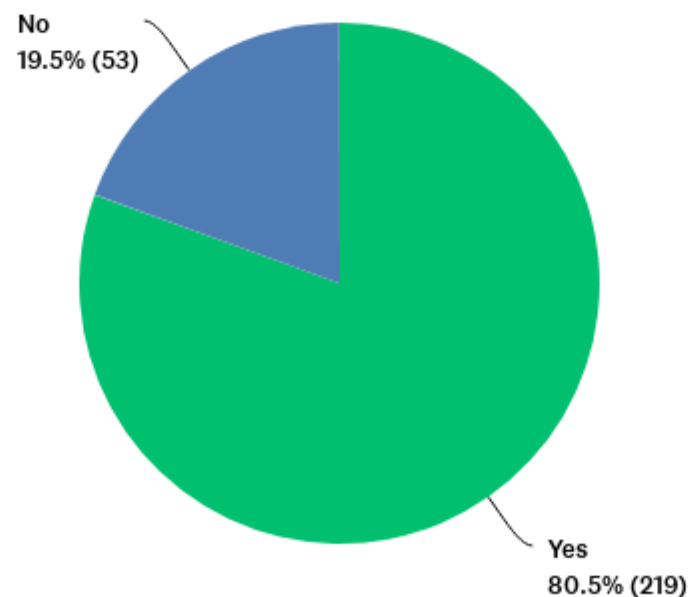

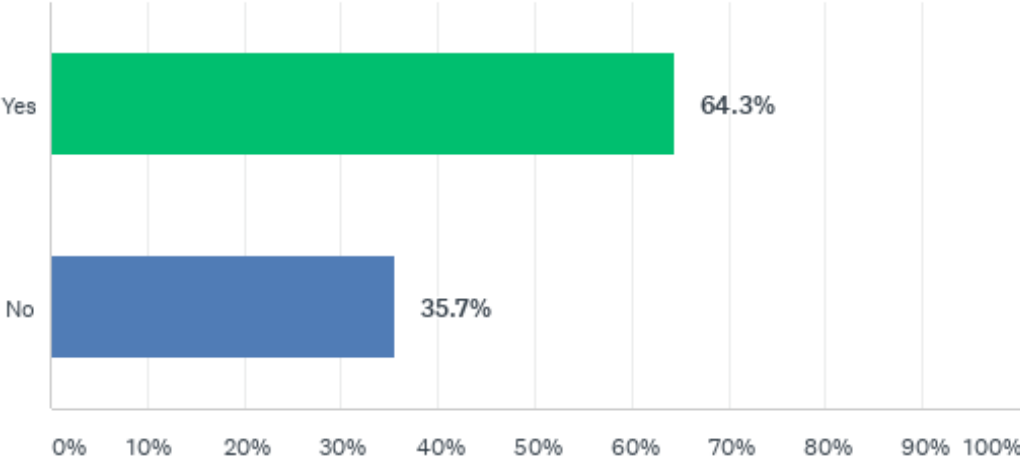

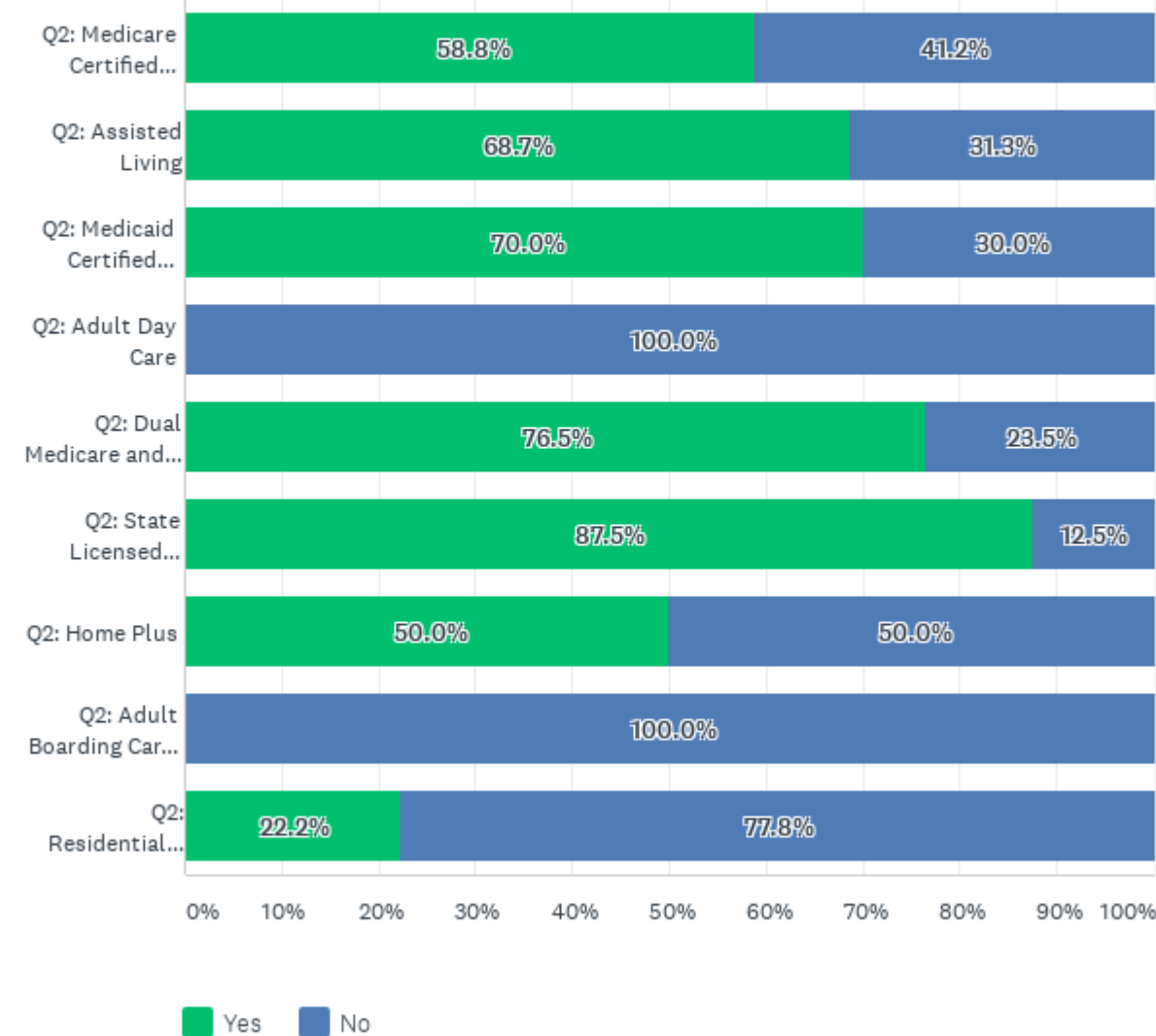
Q18 Do you have an agreement with a “certified” laboratory or laboratory service that can conduct COVID-19 diagnostic testing?



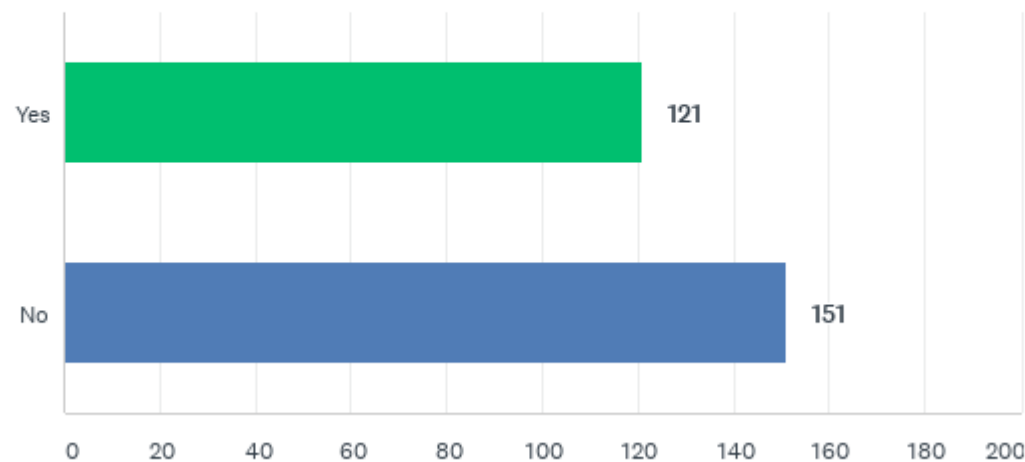
Q24 Can you obtain COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) testing kits for residents in your facility?
