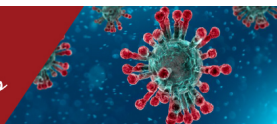

3. PPE funds and ordering portal for state-licensed only. \$575/per bed
PPE ordering for all adult care homes through State Master Contract
1. New KDADS visitation and KDHE testing webinars coming soon
2. Survey on visitor testing requirements – due today!
3. Surveyors now required to wear full PPE when doing surveys. (We are still advocating for surveyor testing.)

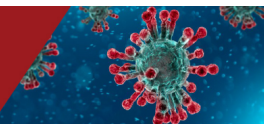
