CMS Reporting Requirements

Applicable to:

Nursing facilities participating in Medicare/Medicaid

Where to report:

CDC National Health Safety Network

Time frame:

At least weekly

What to report:

- Confirmed and suspected COVID infections
- Total deaths
- Total deaths of residents/staff related to COVID
- PPE and hand hygiene supplies
- Ventilator capacity and supplies
- Resident beds and census
- Resident access to testing
- Staffing shortages

KDHE Reporting Requirements

Applicable to:

All adult care homes

Where to report:

- Local health department
 - KDHE COVID-19 Online Reporting Portal

Time frame:

Within 4 hours

What to report:

- Confirmed and suspected COVID infections
- 2+ residents/staff with new on-set symptoms within 72 hours of eachother
- Resident with severe respiratory infections leading to hospitalization or death

Applicable to:

All adult care homes

Where to report:

KDADS Complaint Hotline

Time frame:

Not specified

What to report:

Confirmed COVID infections

CMS Resident/Family Reporting Requirements

Applicable to:

Nursing facilities participating in Medicare/Medicaid

Where to report:

Provider choice on how to inform residents/families

Time frame:

- By 5pm next calendar day
- Weekly cumulative report

What to report:

- Confirmed COVID infections
- 3+ residents/staff with new on-set symptoms within 72 hours of eachother

KDADS Resident/Family Reporting Requirements

Applicable to:

All adult care homes

Where to report:

No parameters given

Time frame:

Within 12 hours

What to report:

- Confirmed COVID infections
- 3+ residents/staff with new on-set symptoms within 72 hours of eachother
