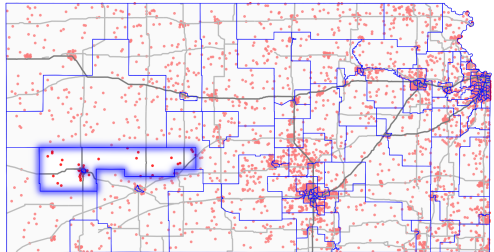
### Providers Within a 30-Minute Drive

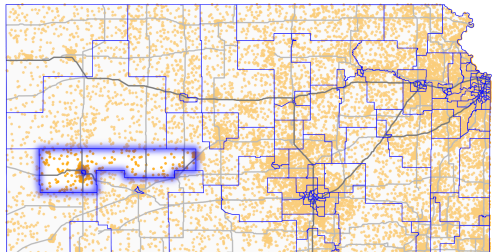
### Where Kansans Aged 85+ Live

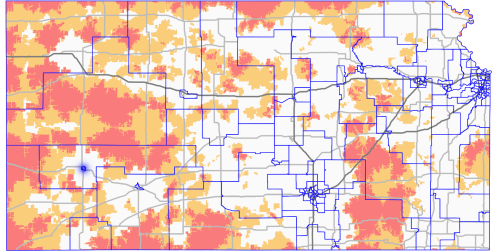

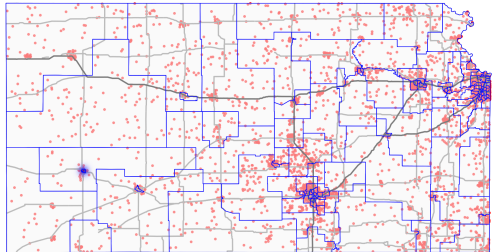
### Providers Within a 30-Minute Drive

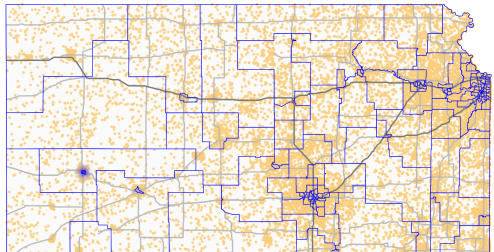
### Where Kansans Aged 85+ Live

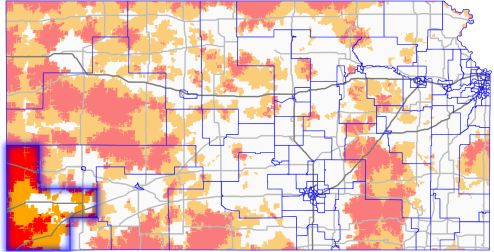

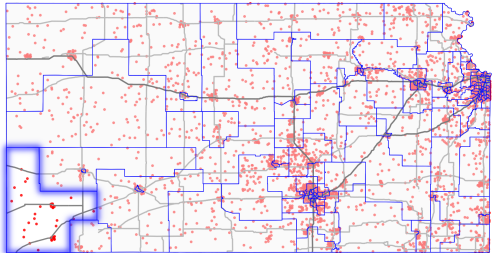

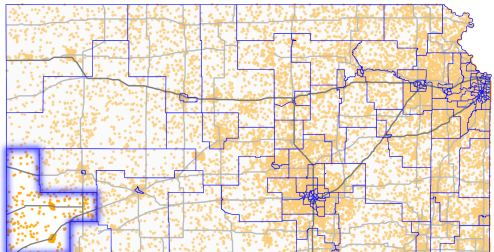
### Where Kansas Aged 85+ Live

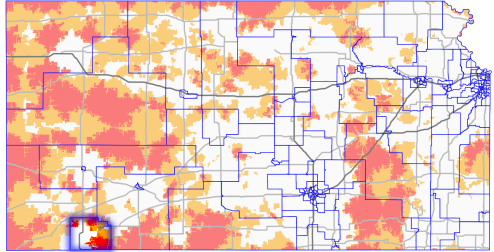

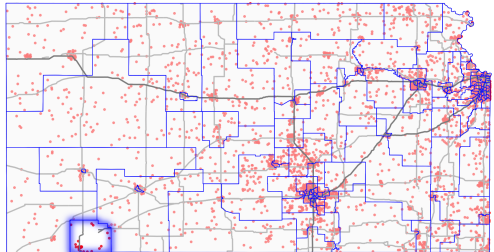
